H-H FAVORITE SUMMER SNACK

INGREDIENTS:

- ½ CUP FAT-FREE OR LOW-FAT VANILLA OR FLAVORED YOGURT
- ½ CUP DICED FRUIT
 SUCH AS GRAPES,
 BERRIES, PINEAPPLE OR
 SLICED PEACHES. IF
 CANNED FRUIT IS USED,
 DRAIN IT FIRST.
- ¼ CUP WHOLE-GRAIN CEREAL
